PRE-ENTRIES should be mailed to the correct person and must be received one week prior to the show date. Pre-Entries may be canceled no later than the Thursday Preceding the show. Refunds will be given up to the show date with proof of injury to horse or exhibitor. No weather related refunds will be given. Checks for pre-entries will not be deposited until after the show. There will be a \$25.00 fee on all returned checks and subject to additional penalties.

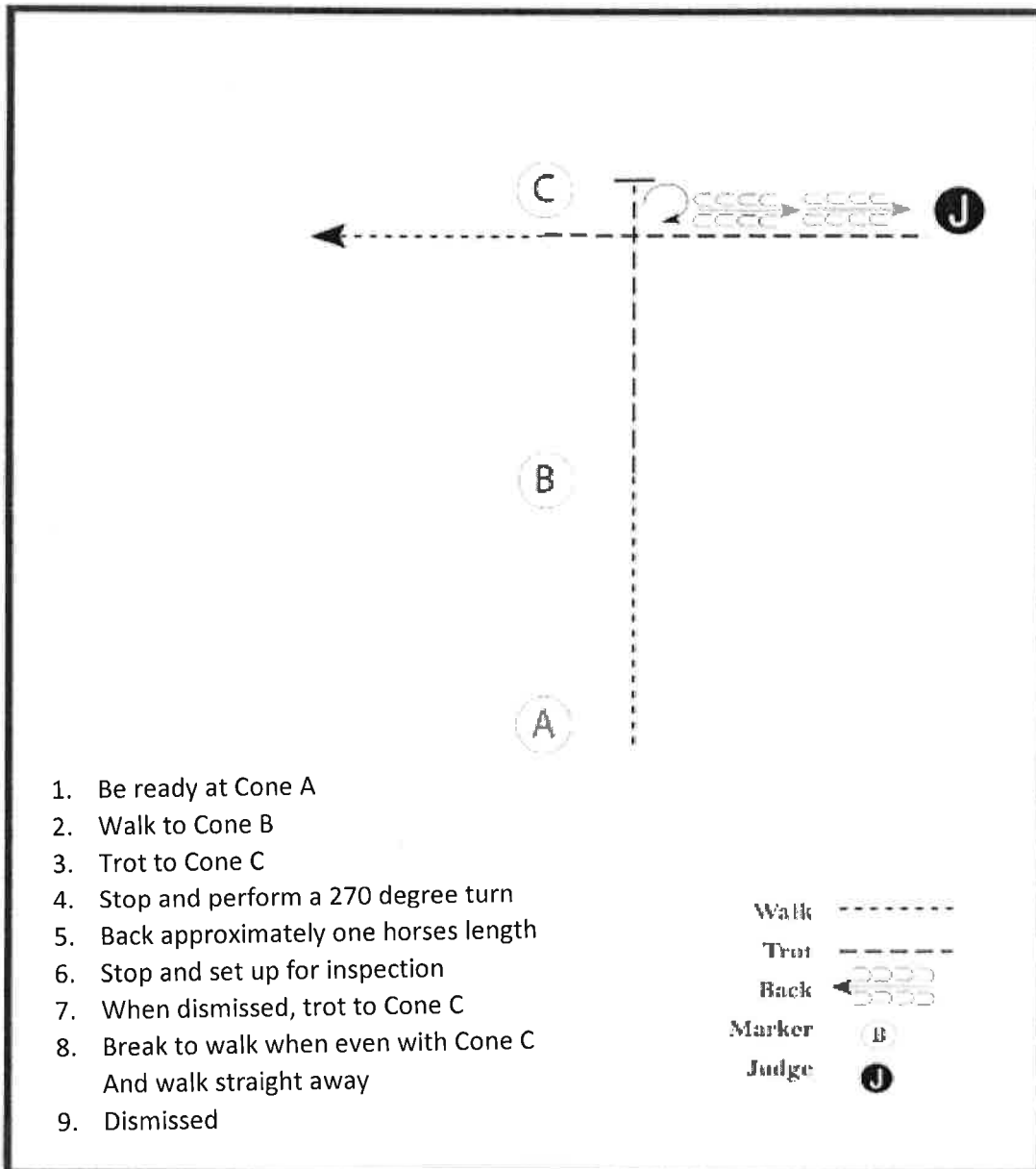
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: All of the above shows are approved for PtHA and PtHAO. Entries must be made in accordance with the current PtHA rules. All horse owners or lessees must show a current PtHA membership card or purchase one at the show. Owners, youth exhibitors, and amateur exhibitors must belong to PtHAO and submit their nomination forms and fees to the Point Secretary in order to be qualified for PtHAO year end awards. PtHA registration papers, type card, or photocopies of both sides of those items must be presented at the show office when entering the show. Show rules are those of the current PtHA National Rule Book. The show management reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split classes as entries warrant. By entering these shows, owners, lessees, and exhibitors agree that PtHA, PtHAO, the show grounds, and the show committee will not be held responsible for any losses, injuries, damages, or debts in connection with these shows. All dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6' while being lead and 10' when tied.

Horse/Pony/Miniature horses staying overnight must be in a stall

PTHAO RULE: Amateur and Youth classes will be combined if less than 5 entries in any Amateur or Youth division. (Jr. & Sr. & Elite, 14-18 & 13 & under)

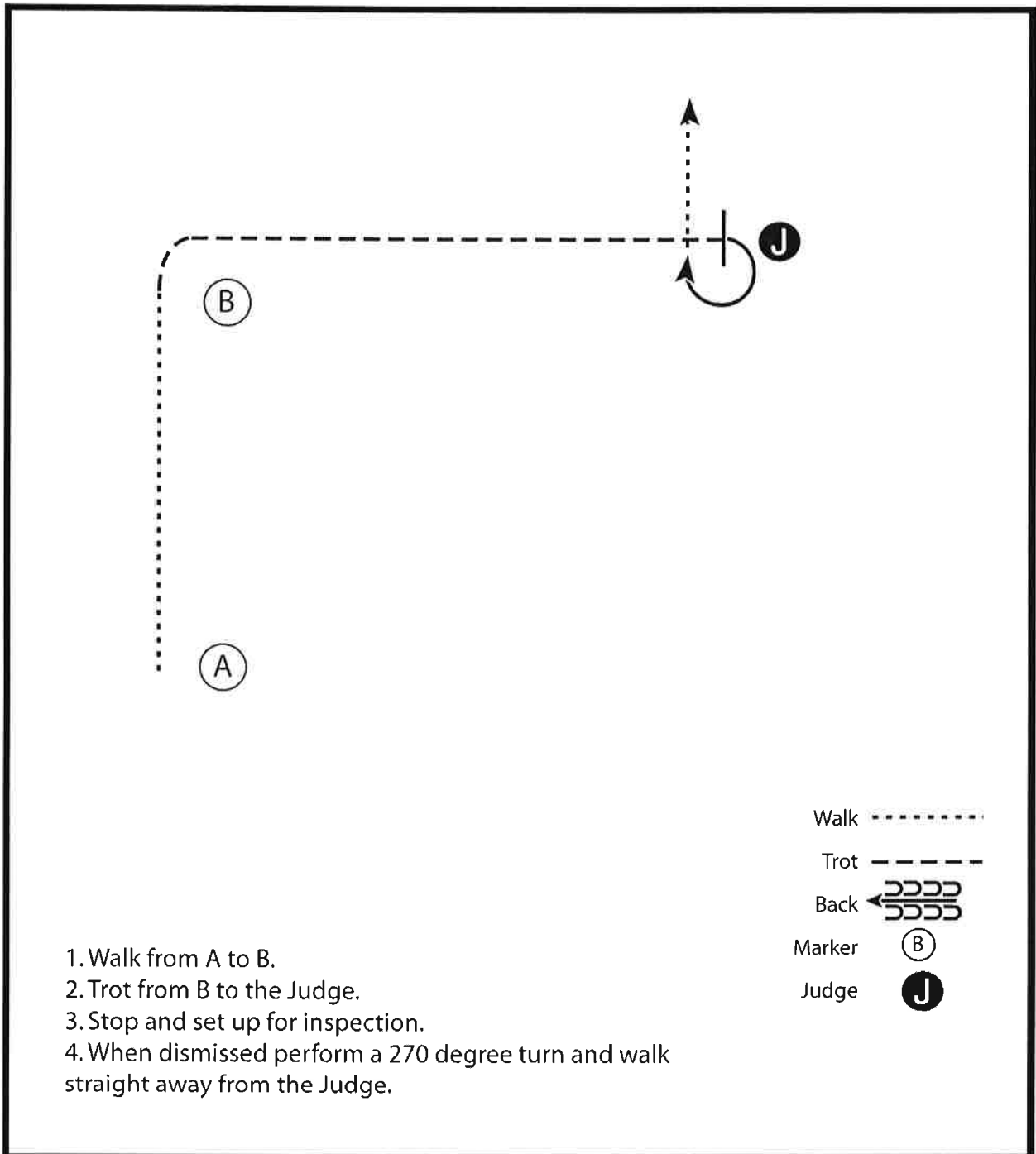

Classes – J2, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20



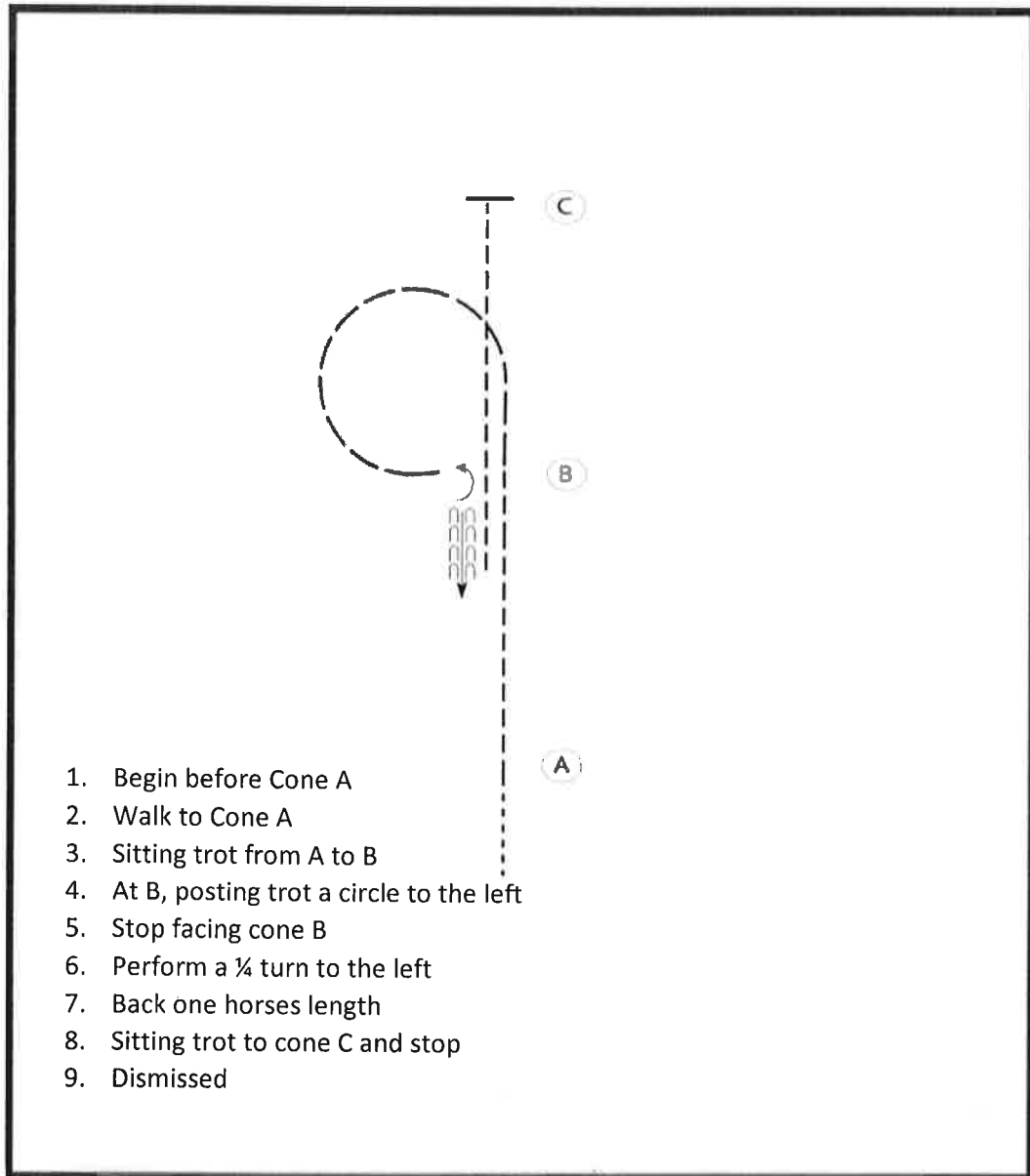
SHOWMANSHIP

Class – 13, 14, 15, 21



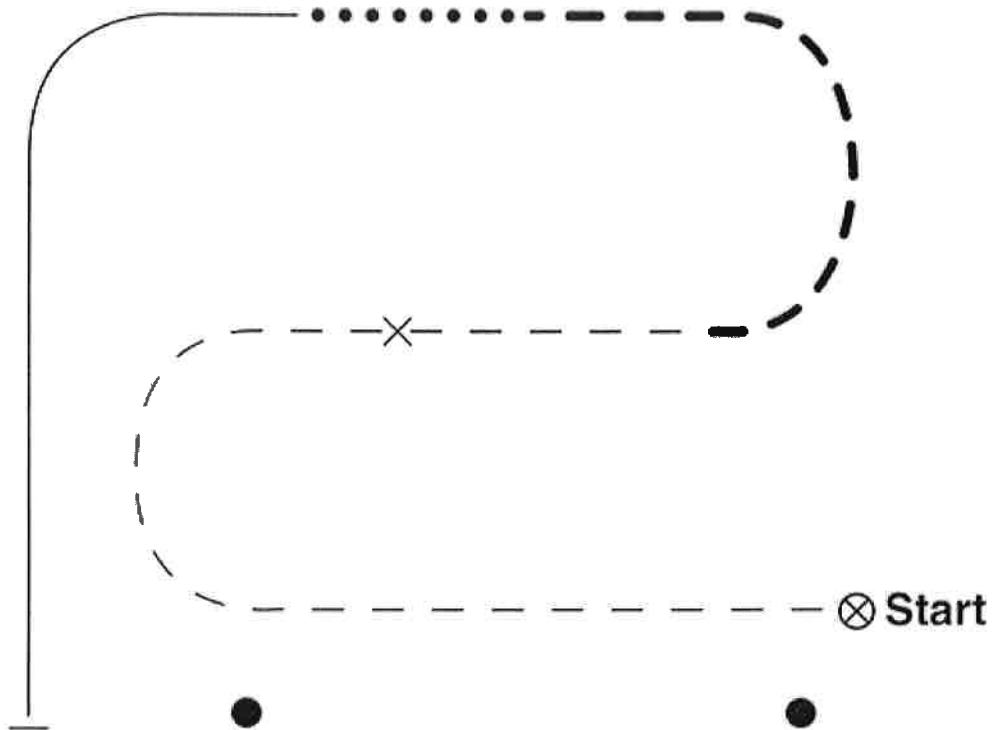
WALK TROT EQUITATION

ENGLISH EQUITATION

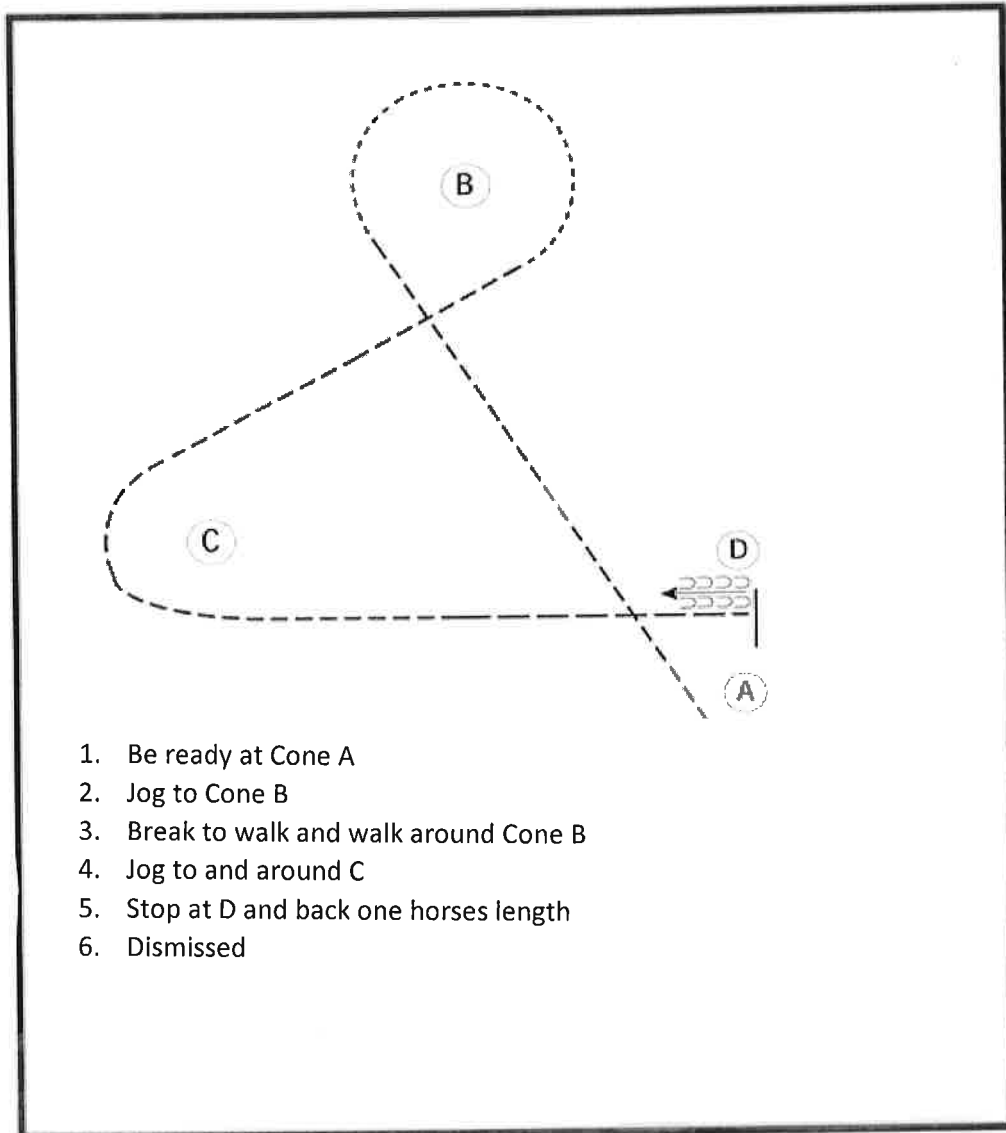

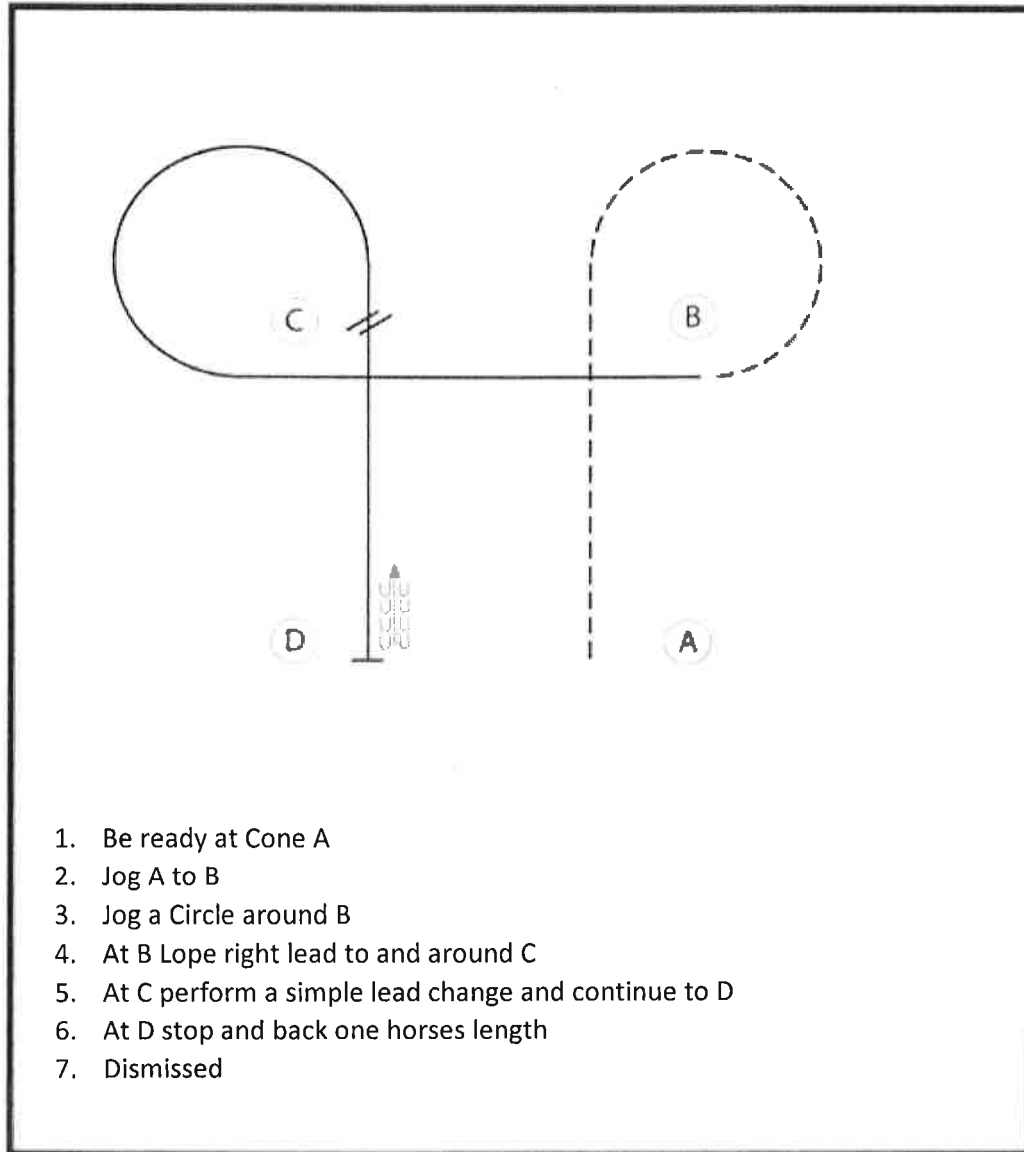
WALK TROT HORSEMANSHIP

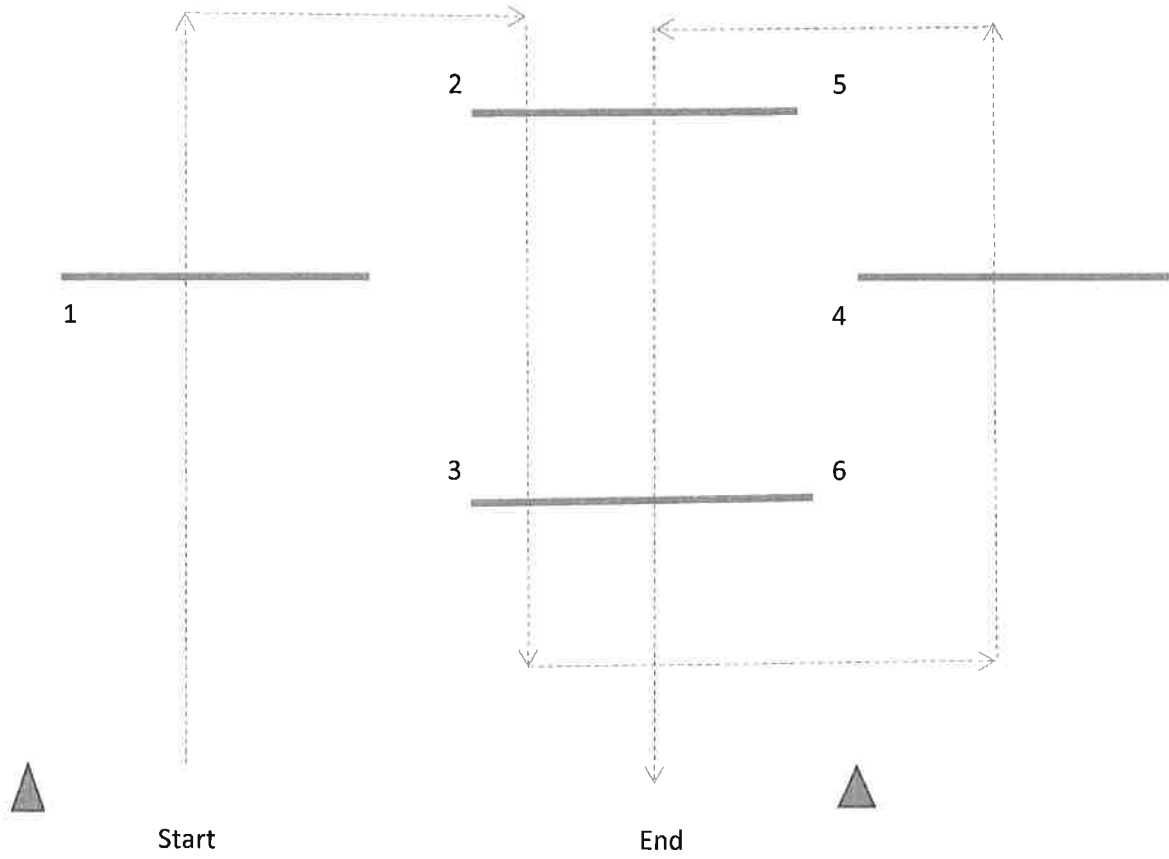


WESTERN HORSEMANSHIP

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Begin at A. Jog from A to B.
2. At B, stop. Execute a 450-degree turn on the haunches to the right.
3. Lope in the right lead a circle to the right.
4. Change leads (flying or simple) and lope in the left (counter) lead an arc to the right to C.
5. At C, stop. Back an arc.
6. Execute a 270-degree turn on the forehand to the left.
7. Walk forward several steps. Pick up the jog and exit the arena at a jog.
