

Ohio Pinto Royalty Contest Rules

Ohio Pinto Queen Contest

Entry Rules:

1. Contestant(s) must be between the ages of 18 and 25 as of January 1st of the representing year. She must not now nor ever have been married and/or had any children.
2. Contestant(s) must be a member of Pinto Horse Association of Ohio and Pinto Horse Association of America.
3. Contestant(s) must be an active member of Ohio Pinto Horse one year before entering the contest.
4. Contestant(s) or her family must own or lease a registered Pinto.
5. If there is more than one contestant, a competition will be held. Contestants will be judged by independent judges on horsemanship (English or Western), horse knowledge, personal interview and attendance. There will be a score given on a scale from 1-25 in each category. The contestant with the most points will not be notified, but will be crowned at the annual awards banquet. If a contest is necessary the horsemanship portion, horse knowledge and personal interview will be judged at the July show.
6. Five (5) attendance points will be given for every PtHAO show or meeting up to a maximum of 25 points from entry deadline through the coronation. Contestant need not show at the show, but must be present and visible to receive points.
7. Contestant will pay a \$10.00 Non-refundable Fee payable to PtHAO.

Duties and Responsibilities of Ohio Pinto Queen:

1. The Queen is strongly encouraged to attend all Ohio Pinto events, including local shows, Equine Affair and the annual awards banquet.
2. The Queen is to give a short speech at the annual awards banquet.
3. The Queen is to help pass out awards at the annual awards banquet and present donated items at the Royalty auction.
4. The Queen is to help present ribbons for the Leadline and Walk/Trot classes at the local shows as her time permits.
5. The Queen will conduct herself in a respectable manner at all times.
6. The Queen will return all crowns, tiaras and the rotating trophy, donated by the Breiding family, prior to the annual awards banquet.
7. The Queen will participate in a fundraiser to benefit the Royalty Contest.

Ohio Pinto Prince, Princess and Sweetheart Contest

Entry Rules:

1. Contestant(s) must be between the ages of 9 and 17 for Prince, 14 and 17 for Princess and between the ages 9 and 13 for Sweetheart as of January 1st of the representing year. They must not now nor ever have been married and/or had any children.

2. Contestant(s) must be a member of Pinto Horse Association of Ohio and Pinto Horse Association of America.
3. Contestant(s) or their family must own or lease a registered Pinto.
4. If there is more than one contestant, a competition will be held. Contestants will be judged by independent judges on horsemanship (English or Western), horse knowledge, personal interview and attendance. There will be a score given on a scale from 1-25 in each category. The contestant with the most points will not be notified, but will be crowned at the annual awards banquet. If a contest is necessary the horsemanship portion, horse knowledge and personal interview will be judged at the July show.
5. Five (5) attendance points will be given for every PtHAO show or meeting up to a maximum of 25 points from entry deadline through coronation. Contestant need not show at the show, but must be present and visible to receive points.
6. Contestant will pay a \$10.00 Non-refundable Fee payable to PtHAO.

Duties and Responsibilities of Ohio Pinto Prince, Princess and Sweetheart:

1. The Prince, Princess and Sweetheart are strongly encouraged to attend all Ohio Pinto events, including local shows, Equine Affair and the annual awards banquet.
2. The Prince, Princess and Sweetheart are to help pass out awards at the annual awards banquet and present donated items at the Royalty auction.
3. The Prince, Princess and Sweetheart are to help present ribbons for the Leadline and Walk/Trot classes at the local shows as their time permits.
4. The Prince, Princess and Sweetheart will conduct themselves in a respectable manner at all times.
5. The Prince, Princess and Sweetheart will return all crowns and tiaras prior to the annual awards banquet.
6. The Prince, Princess, and Sweetheart will participate in a fundraiser to benefit the Royalty Contest.
